SDCL 32-27-1

Motorists are required to yield right-of-way to pedestrians making a proper crossing.

SDCL 32-7-7

*Motorists are required to stop for pedestrians who are crossing the street with the aid of white canes or guide dogs **REGARDLESS** of whether or not they are in a crosswalk.*
